

BCS Grade 1 Supplies

Students are asked to provide the following school supplies. This list represents anticipated supplies for the entire school year for all subjects including art and library. The items will be needed for students in each of the different learning models (in-person, remote learning or distance learning) as identified in the district's reopening plan.

- 1 Pencil box/case
- Headphones with microphone included
- Small package of tissues
- Water bottle(s) (see note below)
- Pocket folders (plastic coated preferred)
 - Red, blue, yellow, green
- 1 One-inch 3-ring binder
- 3 ring zipper pouch
- 1 box of 12 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- Small pencil sharpener with a lid
- 2 Block erasers or cap erasers
- 6 Glue sticks (large preferred)
- Small scissors (Fiskar recommended)
- 4 Black Expo markers (thin preferred) and eraser/cloth
- Crayola crayons- 24 count
- Crayola markers- 10 count
- Sticky notes (at least 2 of both mini and 3x3 size)
- Labeled gallon bag to store extra materials in the classroom



****Please take note: Students' extra materials and other supplies will be stored in a designated location and replenished as needed.****

Special considerations:

Students will be carrying supplies and books back and forth to school. We highly recommend a large backpack. We strongly encourage all students to bring reusable water bottles. Community water fountains will have new procedures restricting drinking directly from the fountain and refilling water bottles. Lastly, we encourage careful consideration related to shoes and your child's ability to tie shoe laces independently.

Suggested items that will be needed to support learning at home which may include distance learning as well as homework or continuing classroom work:

- Crayons
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Dry erase board with markers and erasers
- Composition journal/paper
