

BCS Grade 2 Supplies

Students are asked to provide the following school supplies. This list represents anticipated supplies for the entire school year for all subjects including art and library. The items will be needed for students in each of the different learning models (in-person, remote learning or distance learning) as identified in the district's reopening plan.

- Plastic pencil box/case (small to fit in desk)
- Earbuds or headphones with microphone included
- Small package of tissues
- Water bottle(s) (see note)
- Pocket folders (plastic coated preferred without fasteners)
 - Red, blue, yellow, green
- 2 composition books (wide rule ~ any color)
- 1 box of 12 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 Small pencil sharpener with a lid
- 2 Block erasers or cap erasers
- 6 Glue sticks
- Small scissors (Fiskar recommended)
- 4 Black Expo markers (thin preferred) and eraser/cloth
- Yellow highlighters
- Crayola crayons- 24 count
- Crayola markers- 10 count (either thin or thick)
- Sticky notes (at least 2 of both mini and 3x3 size)
- Labeled gallon bag to store extra materials in the classroom

We strongly encourage all students to bring reusable water bottles. Community water fountains will have new procedures restricting drinking directly from the fountain and refilling water bottles.

****Please take note: Students' extra materials and other supplies will be stored in a designated location and replenished as needed.****

Suggested items that will be needed to support learning at home which may include distance learning as well as homework or continuing classroom work:

- Crayons
- Ruler with inches and centimeters
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Dry erase board with markers and erasers
- Composition journal/paper
