

# BCS Grade 4 Supplies

Students are asked to provide the following school supplies. This list represents anticipated supplies for the entire school year for all subjects including art and library. The items will be needed for students in each of the different learning models (in-person, remote learning or distance learning) as identified in the district's reopening plan.

- Plastic pencil box/case (small to fit in desk)
- Earbuds or headphones with microphone included
- Small package of tissues
- Water bottle(s) (see note)
- Plastic pocket folders (preferred without fasteners)
  - Red, blue, yellow, green
  - Your choice folder to use for school/home papers
- 1 box of 12 sharpened pencils
- Small pencil sharpener with a lid
- 2 Block erasers or cap eraser
- Glue sticks (at least 4)
- Scissors
- 4 Black expo markers (thin preferred) and eraser/cloth
- 2 Highlighters
- Crayola colored pencils- 12 or 24 count
- Crayola thin markers- 10 count
- Sticky notes (at least 2 square pads)
- Labeled gallon bag to store extra materials in the classroom

We strongly encourage all students to bring reusable water bottles. Community water fountains will have new procedures restricting drinking directly from the fountain and refilling water bottles.

**\*\*Please take note: Students' extra materials and other supplies will be stored in a designated location and replenished as needed.\*\***

Suggested items that will be needed to support learning at home which may include distance learning as well as homework or continuing classroom work:

- Colored pencils/markers
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Dry erase board and markers
- Notebook/paper
- Ruler
